This ancient temple is believed to have been established during the Nara period by the decree of Emperor Shomu.

The entirety of Jionji Temple's grounds has been designated as a national historic site. Within these revered grounds stand the main hall, recognized as a nationally designated Important Cultural Property, along with the gate, the Yakushido Hall, and the three-storied pagoda, each bearing witness to the passage of time with solemn grace.

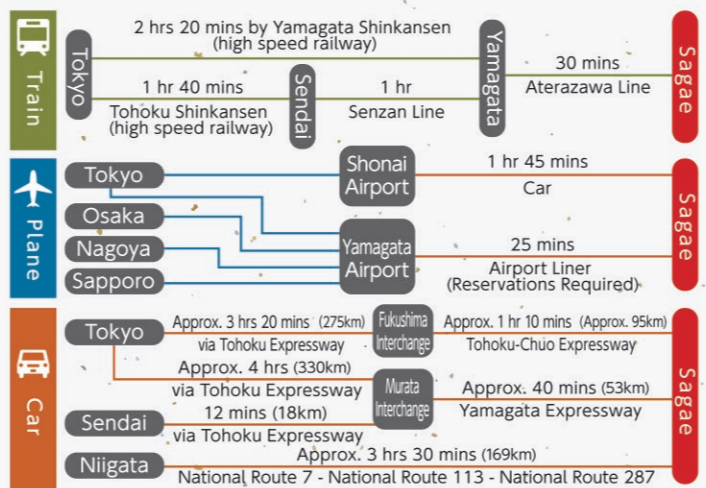

History Passed Down by Jionji Temple

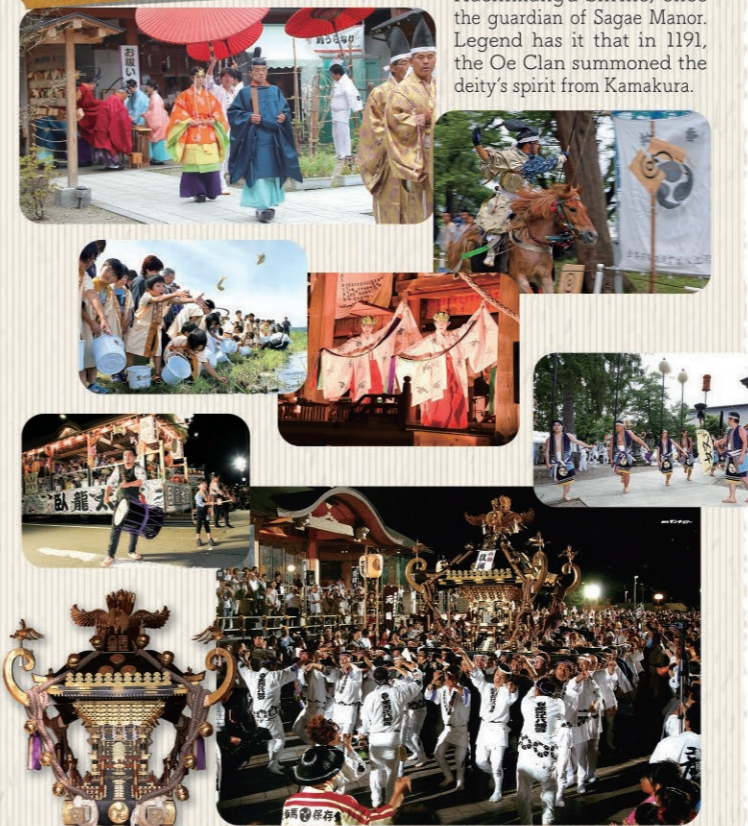


Once a grand temple with 3 noble residences and 48 priest dwellings, this revered site achieved "Goganji" status during the Heian period, designated for imperial prayers by Emperor Toba. In the Edo period, it earned the largest estate (Goshuinch) in the Tohoku region from the shogunate, valued at over 2,812 koku.



Sagae Festival

This festival celebrates Sagae Hachimangu Shrine, once the guardian of Sagae Manor. Legend has it that in 1191, the Oe Clan summoned the deity's spirit from Kamakura.
